JOSEPH AND SARAH HAD A BEAUTIFUL FARM AND A HOUSE ON A HILL.(B10)

SARAH WAS 5 FEET 5 INCHES TALL, SLENDER, 120 POUNDS, LIGHT BROWN HAIR, GRAY BLUE EYES, FAIR COMPLEXION, AND A BEAUTIFUL VOICE. SHE WAS ALWAYS SINGING AROUND THE HOUSE. SARAH WAS THE OLDEST DAUGHTER IN HER FAMILY AND WORKED VERY HARD HELPING HER MOTHER CARE FOR THE YOUNGER CHILDREN. SHE WAS AN EXCELLENT SEAMSTRESS. (B10)

ON THE 31 MAY 1902 JOSEPH WAS STABBED IN THE BACK WITH A POCKET KNIFE BY ANOTHER MAN IN GEORGETOWN ID. HE WAS PARALYZED ON THE LEFT SIDE. HE WAS NO LONGER ABLE TO WORK AND CONFINED TO A WHEEL CHAIR. THEY LOST THEIR FARM AND WERE FORCED TO MOVE TO THE HOUSE AT 1-6. LARETA AND EDWARD WERE BORN HERE. THEY ALSO LIVED AT G-5.(B10)

TO KEEP THE FAMILY TOGETHER SARAH CLEANED THE SCHOOL HOUSE AND TOOK IN WASHING AND IRONING. SHE RAISED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES AND SOLD WHAT THEY COULD SPARE. OCCASIONALLY THEY HAD A CALF, PIG AND SOME CHICKENS.
