According to David Shepherd Clark, this is the second of two known journals of Charles Rich Clark (son of Ezra T. Clark and Mary Stevenson)

Arise in morning at 6:30. Breakfast at 7:00. Leave at 8:00. 212.5 miles to go. Arrive at 9:27. The last 50 miles was the roughest. Holbrook, Res. Yes, no. 2:30. Arizona. Cool. The park is only 2 miles from the depot. St. Joseph on the R.R. 38 miles from Holbrook. Weather fine, yes. Dinner at Winslow. Emma stopped here 3 days. After leaving Williams we went to the depot. The train left at 4:00.

The program started at 8:00. Dinner at Ash Fork. Changed cars at 9:00. Crossed the desert on the R.R. Great desert and great places. First white man to know the Indians. New buildings. Scenery, running water. Arrived at home 10:00.

Geo. Skinner. Collecting guns. Baptist Church, Phoenix. R.R. Cattle ranches, Arizona. 100,000. Big guns, some. Tresda Winery.
