Dear Brother and Sister I thought as I had a few moments to spare I would improve it in writing to you to let you know that I was not at the silver wedding thinking perhaps you were not aware of that fact.. I trust you will not censure me, for circumstances would not permit. I hope you had a very nice time and all [...] and our brothers and sisters were with you. Please write all the particulars.

I wish I could write you that we were all well but Sophia Sisson is very much out of health, she was taken about four weeks ago, and she has a

the little ones are running around here doing all the mischief they can, I wish Sister Mary I could look in and see you and your little ones, and big ones too. Homer and Will send love to all.
