ADA WOULD DO HER WASHING. SHE WOULD HAVE A LARGE TUB OF HOT BOILING WATER ON THE STOVE FULL OF LYE AND SOAP. ONE TIME WHILE TAKING IT OFF IT SLIPPED AND WENT DOWN HER LEG. OH! IT SCALDED REALLY BAD. OINTMENTS WERE PUT ON IT. IT CRUSTED AND THEN WENT BLACK.(IIL)

ADA MADE SOAP FOR OTHERS BECAUSE HERS WAS SO ADMIRED FOR THE CREAMY COLOR AND FINE TEXTURE. ADA ALWAYS TOOK PRIDE IN BEING THE FIRST ONE TO GET HER WASH HUNG ON THE CLOTHES LINE.(BIO)

NEPHI WAS SUPPOSE TO GET THE FIRE-WOOD. ONE DAY ADA AND THE CHILDREN WHEN THEY WERE SMALL WALKED ALONG THE FENCE LINES TO COLLECT WOOD. THEY WERE UNSUCCESSFUL.
