FRANKLIN'S FATHER, JOSEPH, BROTHERS JOSEPH GUISEMPI AND JOHN GIVANNIE, AND HIMSELF CAME TO THE USA FROM NAPLES ITALY TO ESCAPE ANY PROBLEMS WITH THE MAFIA. HIS MOTHER ANTONIA AND SISTER MARIA WERE LEFT IN ITALY. THEY WERE MUSICIANS AND PLAYED ON THE STREET CORNERS TO MAKE ENOUGH MONEY TO COME OUT WEST TO DENVER CO. IN DENVER CO FRANKLIN STARTED SCHOOL. ONE DAY AFTER SCHOOL HE FOUND HIS FATHER AND BROTHERS WERE KILLED MAFIA STYLE. A MAN, LOROCO, BELIEVED TO BE A RELATIVE, TOOK HIM TO SALT LAKE CITY UT AND LEFT HIM AT AN ORPHANAGE ON 15 OCT 1875. HE WAS TIRED AND SAW A BUCKBOARD PARKED IN FRONT OF A CHURCH. HE CRAWLED IN THE BACK UNDER THE CANVAS AND WENT TO SLEEP. WHEN DUDLY HI AND FAMILY CAME OUT OF CHURCH THEY GOT IN THE BUCKBOARD AND DROVE THE TEAM HOME. WHEN DUDLY PUT THE BUCKBOARD AWAY AND TOOK OFF THE COVER TO GET THE THINGS OUT HE FOUND FRANKLIN. FRANKLIN LIVED WITH THIS FAMILY.(Z)

LATER ON FRANKLIN'S MOTHER MOVED FROM ITALY TO NEW YORK CITY USA. SOMEONE GOT HER IN TOUCH WITH HIM. SHE TOLD HIM "I DON'T WANT YOU TO COME AND SEE ME. WE

MAUD SAID SHE WOULD GET BUMB LAMBS AND PUT THEM ON HER HORSE AND TAKE THEM HOME AND RAISE THEM. SHE KNEW DIFFERENT SHEEP RANCHERS AND THEY WOULD SAVE THE LAMBS FOR HER. SHE SAID SHE ALWAYS HAD ABOUT SIX. SHE SAID SHE WOULD GET UP AT FIVE O'CLOCK IN THE MORNING TO MILK THE COWS, TAKE THE MILK FOR HER LAMBS, DIP HER FINGERS IN THE MILK AND LET THE LAMBS SUCK HER FINGERS. THEY HAD NO NIPPLES. THAT IS HOW THE LAMBS WERE FED.(T5)
