SEVERAL THINGS DELAYED THEM AND WHEN THEY GOT TO FARMINGTON UT GEORGE HAD THE MEASLES AND COULDN'T GO ON. HE NEVER MADE ANY CONTACT WITH HIS FAMILY OR FRIENDS AGAIN.(H10)
