THERE WERE TWO ROOMS ON THE HOUSE WITH NO UPSTAIRS AND A SHANTY ON THE BACK OF THE HOUSE FOR A KITCHEN. IT WAS MADE OF LOGS AND LUMBER ON THE INSIDE. THEY TACKED LIGHT TAN FACTORY CLOTH ON THE WALLS.
