HE WOULD GET A DOLLAR, FIFTY CENTS AND SOMETIMES TWO DOLLARS.(H60)

IF HE COULDN'T MAKE MONEY THAT WAY HE WOULD DIG UP DEAD HORSES AND SELL THEIR MANES. THEIR MANE AND TAIL WAS USED IN SUITS TO STIFFEN THE COLLARS. THERE WAS A

JEWISH FELLOW IN MONTPELIER ID WHO BOUGHT THIS FOR SO MUCH A POUND, FIFTY OR SEVENTY-FIVE CENTS. CARL STODDARD(D-3) AND I DID THIS EVEN IN THE WINTERTIME.(H60)

AS A YOUNG GIRL ALICE HAD A HAPPY CHILDHOOD. I GUESS WE WERE POOR BUT WE HAD A LOT OF FUN. ALICE'S FOLKS WOULD TAKE THEM TO THE HILLS FOR SUPPER AND SOMETIMES ALL THEY HAD WAS FRIED POTATOES AND POSTUM.(H60)

WHEN ALICE WAS SIXTEEN YEARS OLD SHE WENT TO MONTPELIER ID TO VISIT HER SISTER, GLENNA ANDERSON BARTSCHI((F-5). THEY WENT TO

AN M-MEN BASKETBALL GAME. SHE SAW LOGAN THERE AND THEIR EYES MET AND IT WAS LIKE ELECTRICITY. WE WENT OUT LATER TO AN OYSTER BAR AND VISITED MOST OF THE NIGHT.(H60)

BISHOP RICHARD SLEIGHT WAS A BIG INFLUENCE IN LOGAN'S LIFE. HE GAVE HIM THE EXTRA HELP AND ENCOURAGEMENT HE NEEDED. LOGAN THEN PLANNED TO GO ON A MISSION. THE PEOPLE OF GEORGETOWN ID GAVE LOGAN A FAREWELL DANCE. THEY DONATED \$105 TOWARDS HIS MISSION. HIS MISSION WAS IN HAWAII. NO ONE WAS THERE TO SEE HIM OFF. ALICE WROTE TO LOGAN WHILE HE WAS ON HIS MISSION. WHILE THERE HE WAS GIVEN PERMISSION TO PLAY ON THE PLANTATION BASKETBALL TEAM. THIS GAVE HIM THE OPPORTUNITY TO TEACH PEOPLE ABOUT THE GOSPEL.
