Wednesday

Studied Arabic; took a lesson in Arabic went down town and practiced speaking with Mr. Gisser: am somewhat encouraged in the language. Hand a few tracts. He tract is "Glad Tidings of Great Joy."

We hold meeting in evening. Read Mosiah.

Jan. 17, 1895

Thursday

Study Arabic hand a few tracts, practice reading and speaking. Mr. Nisser comes in the eve. And we study.

Jan. 18, 1895

Friday

While I was standing in the market today I was invited into a shop of an Arab; a few Arabs gathered round me and we had a pleasant talk on the Gospel. We spoke on the personality of God his

Son and the H.G. And I told them that the angel spoken of in the book of Revelation (XIV 6) had come to the earth with the Gospel and I told them there was only one Gospel. They asked me if they would be allowed in our meeting. I told them to come Sun. at 2 p.m.

Took a lesson in Arabic today. I have discontinued any teaching English for German.

Jan. 18, 1895

Saturday

Am at home nearly all day today go in the city towards evening, however, and have some practice speaking. Received no post today and was disappointed. I read some German from the Bible this evening also from Bo of M. and English also from the Gospel by B.H. Roberts.

Jan. 20, 1895

Sunday
