Clark Sisson] Some things may interest you we got home all right we see Mary Douglas in the City all well I was so glad Lilia had got well again. the Rains up here spoiled most of the hay. Mine was put in Shelter on time. I received your kind letter on my return home also the account of the Temple was? much obeyed. This leaves us all well yours –
