INEZ WAS A GOOD SINGER AND SANG FOR DIFFERENT OCCASIONS. SHE HAD A HIGH SOPRANO VOICE. IF SHE WOULD HAVE HAD THE OPPORTUNITY SHE WOULD OF DONE WELL IN RADIO OR TV.(H59)

HENRY LOREN HOFF WAS ALWAYS NICE LOOKING. HE HAD BROWN EYES AND DARK BROWN HAIR. HE WAS A GOOD NATURED, EASY GOING PERSON AND GOT ALONG WELL WITH EVERYONE. HE WAS A GOOD READER.(H59)

HE LOVED TO ICE SKATE. FOR CHRISTMAS 1908 HE GOT SKATES AND THERE WAS SELDOM A DAY IN THAT WINTER THAT HE DIDN'T GO SKATING DURING THE NOON HOUR OF SCHOOL AND ON SATURDAY AT HOME. HIS FEET AND CLOTHING WERE WET TO HIS KNEES ALL AFTERNOON. MARCH 1909 HE GOT RHEUMATISM, NOW CALLED ARTHRITIS.(H59)
